The Manville Arts Council Art Expo is open to anyone who lives in the state of New Jersey.

#### Is there a fee to take part in the Expo?

The Art Expo is <u>FREE</u> to anyone who wants to participate.

### Are my submitted artworks guaranteed to be in the Expo?

Your application will have a section on it that will ask you to upload images with a description of your work. Please see our Submission Guidelines below for more information. As always, Manville Arts Council reserves the right to decide what is ultimately hung in the show.

# **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

The Manville Arts Council is now taking submissions from New Jersey artists, ages 16 and up, for the 2023 Art Expo.

- Artists are allowed a maximum of 3 submissions. No exceptions.
- Artwork may not exceed 3' in any direction.
- Vertical artwork must be able to hang on a standard J hook. Please refer to our website for proper hanging hardware examples.
- All artwork must be presented display ready.
- Artists are responsible for the structural integrity of all work submitted.
- Sculptures must have a base that is no wider than 18". Work must stand independently, or artist will need to provide a stand for safe displaying.
- Climate control storage or display is not available.
- Artists can only submit work they have created. Private collections of another artist's work will not be considered.
- Art created by Artificial Intelligence cannot be submitted into the Art EXPO.
- The Arts Council cannot accept submissions involving pornography, or the incorporation of weapons of any kind.
- The 2023 Art Expo will be on display at the Manville Library, 100 S. 10th St Manville, NJ 08835 from May 5 to June 2.
- An opening night reception will be held on May 5 from 6:30-8:00pm and is open to the public.
